The Ford Capri



The Ford Capri was Ford's attempt to create a European counterpart to the iconic Ford Mustang. Marketed as "The Car You Always Promised Yourself," the Capri (0) designed to be a sports coupe accessible to the masses.

The Capri's design was heavily influenced by its American cousin, the Mustang, but it was tailored to suit European tastes and roads.
